School Bus Service Ending for Hazelwood!



We have just learned that school bus service will end for Hazelwood students attending our two neighboring schools. We understand that due to budget cuts, students that live within a mile of a school will not be eligible for bus service, starting with the new school year. We want you to be aware of this because this will likely mean increased foot and auto traffic on Wilsonville Road starting in September.
