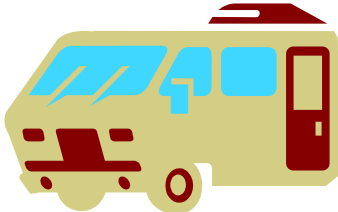
New drain grates have been installed, so we now are in compliance with the latest federal pool regulations.
